- The above tests except the Test of English Language will be available bilingually, i.e. English and Hindi.
- Professional Knowledge test for the following posts combination will be Common.
  - HR scale I and HR scale II
  - Software developer scale I and Software developer scale II
  - Cyber security scale I and Cyber security scale II
  - Credit scale II and Credit scale III



- Enterprise fraud risk management scale II and Enterprise fraud risk management scale III
  - Cyber security scale III and Cyber security scale IV
  - Accounts (CA) scale III and Accounts (CA) scale IV
  - Risk scale III and Risk scale IV
- There will be no negative marking in the online written examination.
  - The minimum qualifying marks/percentage of marks in English Language, General Awareness and Professional Knowledge would be 40% for General & EWS Category and 35% for Reserved Categories. However, the Bank reserves the right to change the minimum qualifying criteria for written test at its sole discretion.
  - The weightage for written Test Score & Interview marks will be 70% & 30% respectively. The final merit list for selection will be prepared by clubbing the marks of written Test & Interview.
  - Candidates are required to obtain a minimum qualifying score in each test /section and also a minimum qualifying total score in the online test to be shortlisted for Personal Interview. Prior to the completion of the interview process, scores obtained in the online examination will not be shared with the candidates shortlisted for interview. Only Professional Knowledge marks will be considered for preparing final merit list for interview.
  - Other detailed information regarding the examination will be given in an Information Handout which will be made available for the candidates to download along with the call letters through Bank's website.
